This is a technical tournament for colour and black belt competitors of all ages; Junior, Open and Masters divisions.

Detailed competition information is enclosed.

Perhaps the most exciting innovation this year is the \$1,000 scholarship for any TA member for best "Junior" (14 – 35 years), as well as best "Senior" (36 years plus), competing in the "Division 1" category. These funds will be available to the winner to help pay for any TVI or TA recognised competition, thus encouraging our players to continue to develop their skills.

Please also be aware that all athletes must bring their **signed** confirmation of entry form from the online entry process as well as photo identification, to the Registration Desk in order to be permitted access to the tournament.

Competition entries close on Friday 14th May, 2010. Please Note: as the online system is fully automated, no late entries can be processed after this date.

General Information

- Eligible Competitors:** To be eligible to contest the Victorian “Open Muye Championships”, athletes must:
- be a registered member of Taekwondo Australia Inc (2010)
 - have at all times acted in a proper manner and not have engaged in any conduct that would bring the Association, our sport or any of our staff into disrepute or censure.
- Registration:** All competitors **MUST** bring their current 2010 Taekwondo Australia registration card. Players without registration cards will not be permitted to compete.
- Competition Schedule:** **Saturday 22nd May, 2010 (indicative only)**
Officials and Judges arrive 2.00 pm
All belts registration at 2.30 pm
Competition Starts 3.00 pm Sharp
- Liability:** All participants in the tournament take part at their own risk. The organiser can under no circumstances be held responsible for any damages, injuries, or loss to individuals or equipment.
- Spectator Prices:** **Adults:** \$15 **Under 15:** \$5 **Under 6:** Free
Family: \$30 (2 adults+3 children)
- Divisions:** Final divisions will be decided once all applications have been received. In the event of an uncontested competitor, the competitor may choose to enter another division, compete alone (thus winning 1st place), or ask for a full refund.

Event Rules

- Awards:** Medals or trophies will be awarded to First, Second and Third place in all divisions. In the “One on One” competition there will also be an award for the “Repechage winner”.

“One on One” Poomsae

- Tournament Rules:** Two players compete at the same time. Judges will award a winner based on majority decision at the end of the match. The winner progresses to the next round. Losers in first round will all progress to the “repechage” round. Judging based on the following criteria: First “accuracy”, then “power”, then “expression of Ki”, then “best artistic impression”.

The “Scholarship” competition will be held between the winners in all “Division 1” categories of the relevant age groups.

“Pairs” Poomsae

- Tournament Rules:** Each Pair must consist of one male and one female competitor. Both contestants must be in the same age group. If contestants are of different grading, they will be entered at the level of the higher partner. That is – one Yellow Belt and one Black belt compete as Black Belt. Judging will be out of 10.0, with WTF style judging rules applied. One pair will compete at a time!

“Team” Poomsae

- Tournament Rules:** Each Team must consist of either three males OR three female competitors. All contestants must be in the same age group. If contestants are of different grading, they will be entered at the level of the higher partner.

Individual Music Poomsae

- Tournament Rules:** Each contestant should complete an individually choreographed routine to music. The pattern will be judged on “artistic merit” as well as Taekwondo technique. Routines must be based on Taekwondo technique. No weapons, “props” or “partners” permitted! (only hands and feet!) Minimum dress standard is Taekwondo dobok pants. (Tasteful / modest uniforms required!) Deduction for under / over time = 0.5 /10.0 (time = 60 to 120 seconds!)

Technical Breaking

- Tournament Rules:** This competition is for “Senior” members only. That is, over 18 years of age as at 22nd May. Minimum Rank is Black Belt. Each contestant must supply own holders. TVI will supply holders with safety goggles / face shields, which **MUST** be worn by all participants. Male contestant’s boards are 20mm in thickness and 300mm square. Female contestant’s boards

are 15mm in thickness and 300mm square. Contestants must notify TVI of number of boards required on application form. All boards will cost \$4.00, and will be supplied by TVI. (unbroken boards may be taken home by contestant). No padding is to be worn on the hands or feet when breaking. Scoring to be determined as per the Breaking scoring sheet (Appendix I, attached). NB – five “breaks” are to be performed, each of a different technique.

Power Breaking

Tournament Rules:

This competition is for “Senior” members only. That is, over 18 years of age as at 22nd May. Minimum Rank is Black Belt. Power Breaking is for hand techniques only. Male contestant’s boards are 20mm in thickness and 300mm square. Female contestant’s boards are 15mm in thickness and 300mm square. Contestants must notify TVI of number of boards required on application form. All boards will cost \$4.00, and will be supplied by TVI. (unbroken boards may be taken home by contestant). No padding is to be worn on the hands when breaking. 10mm spacers will be used by contestants between boards (supplied by TVI). Power break will be performed on two standard size cement blocks (supplied by TVI). No jumping will be allowed when power breaking. In case of a draw the lighter player wins.

Siljyon Kyorugi

Tournament Rules:

This is a “pairs” competition, players may choose to wear Taekwondo protectors, such as a hogu, or not. Time limit = 60 to 120 seconds. Think “action movie fight scene”. Techniques permitted are all Taekwondo techniques, including grabbing and throws. No weapons are permitted. See attached sheet for judging criteria. (Appendix ii). Any “injury” incurred will result in disqualification of both contestants.

Demonstration Team Competition

Tournament Rules:

This is a “team” competition, with a minimum of three players. The demonstration is to take place within the confines of a 12m x 12m court. Time allowed is a maximum of three minutes. Music may be used to accompany the routine. Disqualification of the team will occur if any member is injured during the routine. See attached sheet for judging criteria. (Appendix ii). Deduction for under / over time = 0.5 / 10.0 (time = 120 – 180 seconds!)

SILJYON KYORUGI (“Real Fighting”)

Rules for Judging / Advice for competitors

TIME LIMIT 60 – 120 seconds (0.5 deduction for under / over time)
Judging ceases at end of 2 minutes!

2 Players

Should look like an “action movie fight scene”

JUDGES CRITERIA

- 1 Continuous movement
- 2 No weapons
- 3 Grabbing / throwing allowed
- 4 Should look “real”
- 5 Requires a variety of actions
- 6 Must show Taekwondo spirit
- 7 NO INJURIES
- 8 Any “wrestling” should be kept to a minimum (regain feet in 2-3 seconds)

NOTES Players may choose to wear hogu / other protective equipment if desired
Any injury incurred will result in disqualification of both competitors

DEMONSTRATION TEAM COMPETITION

Rules for Judging / Advice for competitors

TIME LIMIT 120 - 180 seconds (0.5 deduction for under / over time)
Judging ceases at end of 3 minutes!

MINIMUM 3 Players

No rank or age restrictions apply

Minimum dress standard is Taekwondo dobok pants. (Tasteful / modest uniforms required!)

JUDGES CRITERIA

- Music may be used to accompany the demonstration
- Routine must fit within the confines of a 12m x 12m court
- Minimum Dress standard
- Demonstration may include
 - Poomsae
 - Self Defence
 - Sparring
 - Breaking
 - Any other “Taekwondo” technique

Scoring will be based on Artistic merit as well as Taekwondo Technique.

“Difficult” skills displayed (such as 540 spin kicks) will bring bonus scores, however, skills performed that show poor control or in any way endanger the participants will be deducted.

NOTES Any injury incurred will result in disqualification of the team.
